The Seniors Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) is now offering **Shopper Card** benefits up to \$50 for Native American Senior Adults (age 55 and older) and Non-Native American Senior Adults (age 60 and older), who live in New Mexico. Those eligible will be able to buy locally grown fruits, vegetables, cut herbs, and honey from select farmers' markets, mobile farmers' markets, and roadside stands across the state.

Eligibility Requirements Include:

1. **Age -**

- 55 years of age or older (Native Americans)
- 60 years of age or older (non-Native American)

2. **Participate or Qualify for -**

- SNAP (NM Food Stamp Program)
- TEFAP (The Emergency Food Assistance Program)
- Senior Food Boxes
- ECHO - Food Bank
- Salvation Army - Food Bank
- Loaves & Fishes - Food Bank **OR**
- Any other food distribution program

OR meet the above age requirement and meet the below income level

3. **Income Level -** must not exceed the following 185%

2023-2024 Federal Poverty Limits:

- \$2,248 for a household of 1
- \$3,041 for a household of 2
- \$3,833 for a household of 3
- \$4,625 for a household of 4
- \$5,418 for a household of 5
- \$6,210 for a household of 6
- \$7,003 for a household of 7
- \$7,795 for a household of 8
